

Follow the steps below to make your own embroidered clothes!
This is a beginner-friendly activity for ages 13 and above.

Supplies:

- Embroidery hoop
- Piece of clothing
- Fabric + embroidery thread
- Needle + scissors

Step 1: Form the patch

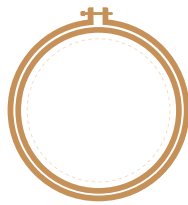


Look for a small hole in the clothing or gently cut a quarter-sized hole in the clothing.



→ Trim a piece of fabric so there is about ½ inch extra fabric around the circumference.

Step 2: Attach fabric



Place the fabric on the inside of the hole.



Place in an embroidery hoop or secure with pins.

Step 3: Embroidery



Double thread a needle with your color of choice.



Choose a fun pattern to embroidery around the edge of the hole.

Trim the fabric. Enjoy!
