This is a beginner-friendly activity for ages 13 and older.

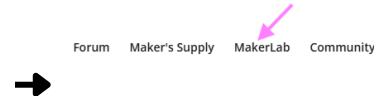
Supplies:

- Creativity & fun

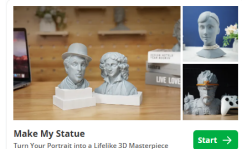
Step 1: Access Maker World & Lab



Go to
Makerworld.com.
Create an account.

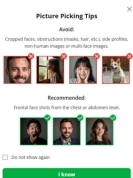


Click on
MakerLab

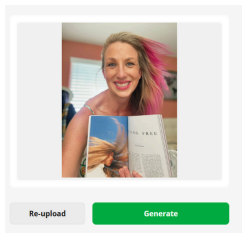


Click on "Make My
Statue" Start button.

Step 2: Upload image



Click on "New
Project."
Verify that
you will only
use human
faces.



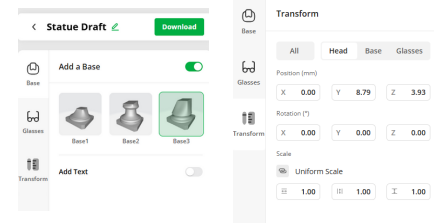
Click to add a
picture (find one
online or login to
the Cloud and
download one).
Then, click
"Generate."

Step 3: Customize statue

Please Confirm the Generated Result



Wait for it to
generate. Press
"Confirm" if you are
satisfied. Confirm
credit usage.



Add a base + text and/or
glasses. Turn on the feature
and view it from 3
dimensions. Click on
Transform to move objects.
Be careful.

Title it your name + Statue.

Click Download → 3MF.

Go to cedarparktexas.gov/makerspace -> Tools -> Prototyping -> 3D Printers. Submit a 3D print request.
