Follow the steps below to make your own sock animal!
This is a beginner-friendly activity for ages 8-12.

Supplies:

- 1 pair socks + cotton balls
- Felt + Stuffing beads
- Buttons + Thread
- *Needle

Step 1: Prep & Cut



Cut the foot part of two socks.



Cut felt into eyes, nose, mouth, and any other accessories.

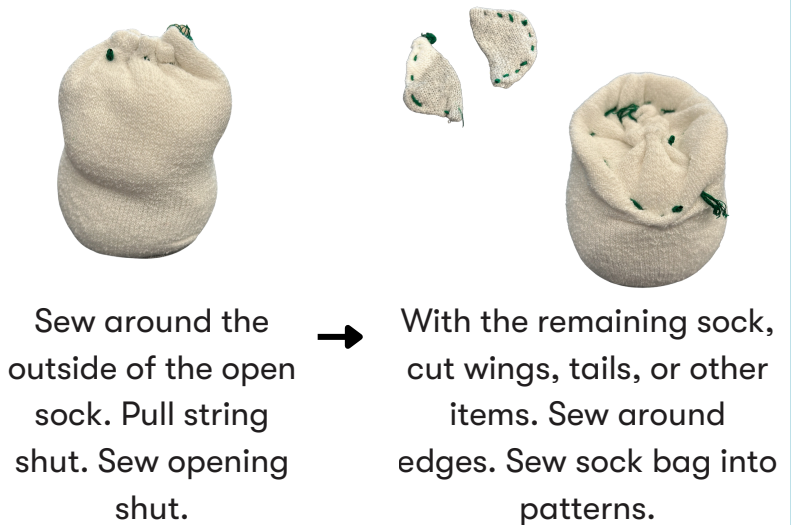
Step 2: Bean pack



Sew around the cut side of one sock. Fill we beads. Pull the string shut. Sew the opening shut.

→ Put the bean back in the other sock. Cover with cotton balls.

Step 3: Finalize jewelry



Sew around the outside of the open sock. Pull string shut. Sew opening shut.

→ With the remaining sock, cut wings, tails, or other items. Sew around edges. Sew sock bag into patterns.

Sew or glue on felt + buttons + other sewn creations. Enjoy!
