Follow the steps below to make your own unique fall art!
This is a beginner-friendly activity for ages 13-18.

Supplies:

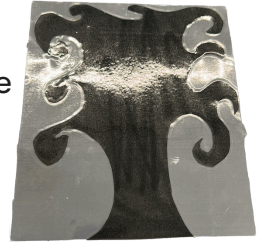
- Alcohol ink
- Contact paper
- Black + white cardstock
- Rubbing alcohol
- Eye dropper + cotton swabs + masking tape

Step 1: Add black-out art



Draw a fun fall creation on black cardstock (only draw on 7" x 8").
Cut it out.

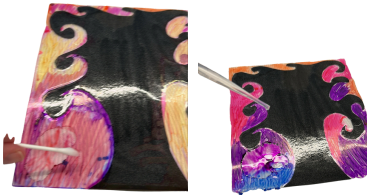
Place one contact sheet with sticky side up. Remove the backing. Place in your object. Place another contact sheet on top. Smooth it out.



Step 2: Background



Color the background with alcohol ink markers. You don't have to be perfect.



Dip swab in rubbing alcohol. Blend ink. Use eyedrop to drip rubbing alcohol on it.

Step 3: Add frame



Cut a piece of white cardstock to go behind the art.



Use masking tape to tape the edges of the cardstock to the art.
