

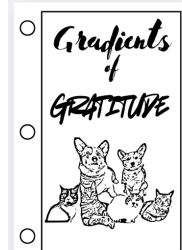
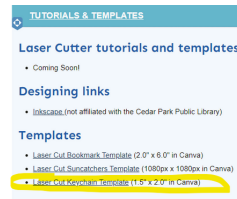


Follow the steps below to make your own wood journal!
This is an intermediate activity for ages 55 and above.

Supplies:

- Basswood
- *Canva
- Watercolor paper
- Binder rings + hole punch

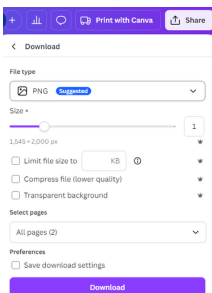
Step 1: Design the cover



Go to the CPPL Makerspace site and make a copy of the Laser Engraved Notebook file (on laser cutter page). You will need a Canva account.

Title your design with your name. Add black & white designs & text onto the sign.

Step 2: Export the file

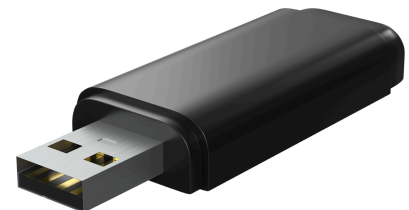


Click Share.
Choose to download as a PNG>



Go to picsvg.com. Upload your file. Change the setting to your favorite and download.

Step 3: Send the file



We will upload your new file to a USB. Please do not leave until we have yours saved. Title yours with your first and last name.

All files will be proofed and prepared for next class.





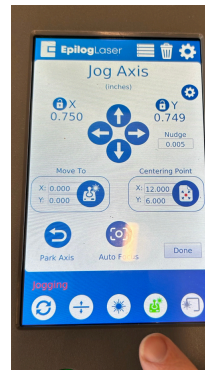
Follow the steps below while using the laser cutting and engraving machine

Step 1: Prep the materials



Open laser lid.
Place basswood
piece against top
left corner.

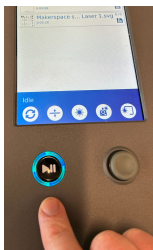
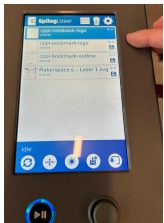
Step 2: Focus the laser



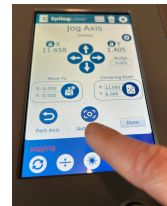
On screen, click on
4th button. Move
joystick so red dot is
over where you're
cutting



Step 3: Engraving/Cutting



Click on the 3
lines. Then, click
on
"[NameMap]".
Press the play
button.



Click on
autofocus.
Then, press
done when it
is complete

**Watch the laser to ensure it is cutting safely.
When it finishes, it will beep. Open the lid and
remove items.**





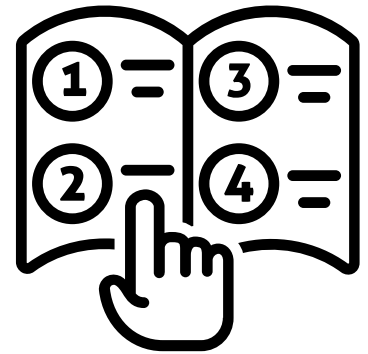

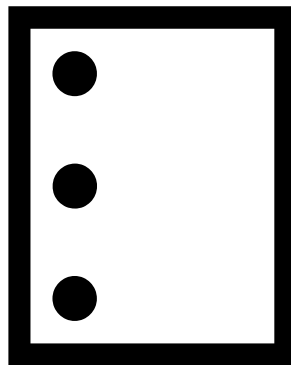
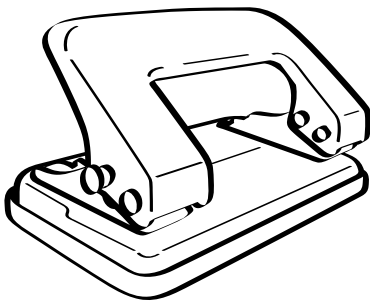

Step 1: Laser Engrave

Follow the instructions on page 2 to laser engrave your notebook cover. We will have a back cover already provided for you. While you wait to engrave, please try steps 2 and 3.

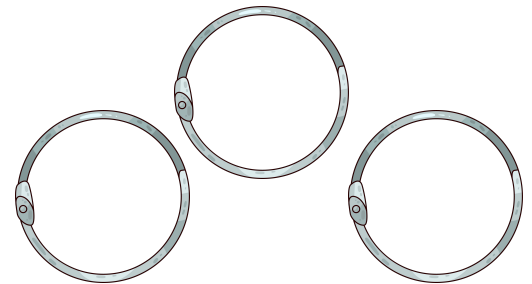


Step 2: Add page



Take a total of 10 page. Use the 3-hole punch or single hole punch to punch holes that match your back cover. Begin to decorate pages if you have time!

Step 3: Add rings



Place the bottom cover on the table. Place your 10 page on top of it. Then, add the front cover. Add a ring to each of the holes. 3 total.



Add journaling pages as you go. Draw, write, doodle, etc. Enjoy!
