



Follow the steps below to make your own needle felted garland!
This is a beginner-friendly activity for ages 55 and up.

Supplies:

- Wool
- Felting pad and needle
- Wooden skewer
- Twine/strong thread (12 “)

Step 1: Setting up the garland



Choose up to two colors of wool.
Grab a small fistful of each wool.



Pinch off a small piece of wool (~ size of index finger x 2 in length).



Twist and mold the piece into a small ball.

Step 2: Felting - CAUTION



Use a felting needle and a pad. Hold the needle at 90 degrees. Put the ball on the pad.

Slowly move the needle & down into the felt ball.
Continue with new angles to make ball.

Step 3: Felting



Use a skewer to poke and twist a hole into the ball.



Use the skewer to push a piece of twine into ball. Tie a knot around the first ball. Repeat steps 1-3 for remaining balls.



Continue steps 1-3 until string is full.
Tie knot around last ball. Hang and enjoy!
