



Follow the steps below to make your own Neurographic art!
This is a beginner-friendly activity for ages 8-12.

Supplies:

- Watercolor paper
- Black permanent marker
- Acrylic paint + brush
- Acetate + paper portrait
- Pencil

Step 1: The Acetate

Place Acetate sheet on your printed portrait. Use the black sharpie to trace it (face, nose, ears, eyes, hair, shirt, borders, etc.)



Use acrylic paint to paint the back of the acetate (remember that it will be in reverse).



Step 2: Permanent-ing



Put Acetate on top of watercolor paper.

Begin by drawing marker loops across the paper. Gradually add more. Make big and small intersections.

Step 3: Watercolor



Where lines intersect, smooth out & color in the corners with a black and/or gold permanent marker.

Add paint/patterns / words of gratitude to each of the newly created circles (or skip some if you want)



Once it is dry, you may frame it, turn it into a card, or just enjoy. Share at **#CpplMakes**
