



Follow the steps below to make your own embroidery pumpkin!
This is a beginner-friendly activity for ages 55 and above.

Supplies:

- Embroidery hoop
- Sweater/sock
- Leaves, stick, string
- Pipe cleaner, glue, hot glue

Step 1: Form the pumpkin



Cut a sock so it lays flat.
Place it in embroidery hoop.

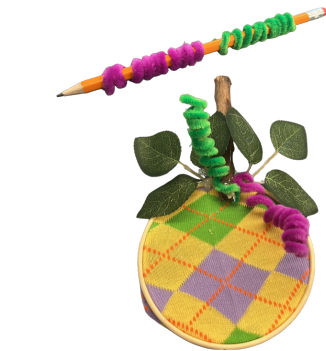
Trim around the frame.
Hot glue a stick to the top of the frame.



Step 2: Add leaves



Hot glue leaves to the stem.



Wrap a pipe cleaner around a pencil to make a vine. Hot glue vine to frame.

Step 3: Add vines



Soak a few 12" pieces of jute twine in Mod Podge or glue.



Wrap it around a pencil. When it is almost dry, remove it and hot glue it to the frame.

Hang and enjoy!
