



Follow the steps below to make your own seed paper!
This is a beginner-friendly activity for all ages.

Supplies:

- Newspaper
- Construction Paper
- Water, blender, tub, strainer
- Ribbon (optional)

Step 1: Prepping the paper

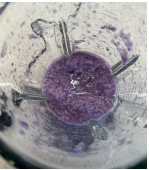


Tear 1 sheet of construction paper into 1 in. cubes. Put in blender.



Add water so that paper is entirely covered. You may need to add more water.

Step 2: Blend

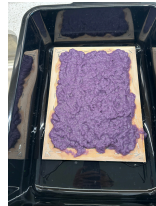


Blend to a pulp. Add more water if needed.



Put a flat strainer (wire frame) in an empty tub. Pour pulp over strainer **Add in paper/string if desired).

Step 3: Strain



Make sure pulp covers the strainer. Use fingers lightly if necessary.



Let water drain out of strainer until just a drip. Flip strainer over gently onto absorbent towels. Put paper towel on top to squeeze out extra water.



**Let dry for 1-2 days. When dry, trim into desired shape and plant.

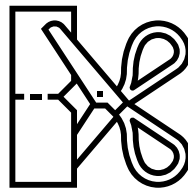


Follow the steps below to make your own Winter paper!

- Markers
- Scissors

Step 1: Trimming the paper



Cut off any extra rough edges on your paper.



Cut paper into any fun designs of your choice.

Step 2: Text

January

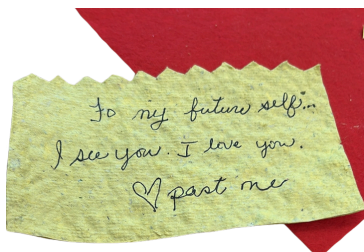


Add text with fun markers. Add extra designs and decorations to your liking as well.

Step 3: Sealing



Roll your paper into a scroll or seal it in an envelope to deliver. Paper is fragile, so it may not scroll.
