



Follow the steps below to make your own buttons (up to two)!
This is a beginner-friendly activity for ages 5+ (supervision needed).

Supplies:

- Button back + top
- Button mylar
- Button image + scissors
- Creativity & fun

Step 1: Pick three images

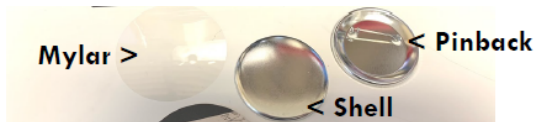


Choose up to two
images/blanks. Draw
on the blanks.



Use the 2.25" punch cutter
to cut the circles.

Step 2: Get materials



Get a 2.25" mylar circle, shell,
and pinback.

Step 3: Punch button



Place the shell on the
shell side of the button
maker. Put the image
on top of the shell. Put
the mylar on the very
top. On the crimp side,
place the pinback
smooth side down so it
makes a face.



Use the lever to press
down on the shell.
Swing the press and
press down on the
crimp side.



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
