



Follow the steps below to make your own paper wreath!
This is a beginner-friendly activity for ages 8 and above.

Supplies:

- Foam wreath + ribbon
- Paper plate ~3-5
- 2 sheets colored paper
- Scissors + hot glue

Step 1: Cut & Trace Circles



Use a dixie cup or smaller to trace
2-3 different sizes of circles on
plates & colored paper.



Cut all circles out.

Step 2: Shape Rosettes



Cut circle into a spiral pattern. You'll end in
the middle of the circle
with a smaller circle.



Have pattern side up &
roll paper from the
outside until you get to
the middle of the circle.

Step 3: Glue



Place dab of hot glue on inner
circle and plop rolled-up flower on
top of glue. Hold in place until glue
dries. Place big rosettes in a line
on the top part of the foam
wreath. Fill in spaces with rest of
the rosettes.



**Add string and
hang!**
