

### Step 2: Design

## Reversible Sequins Pillow Cases Option 1

Follow the steps below to make your own sequins pillow case.

### Supplies:

- Reversible sequin case
- Sublimation paper
- Digital image
- Sublimation markers

### Step 1: Draw an image




Think of a fun design. Use the sublimation markers to draw it. It will be flipped, so be careful with text.



Cut the image so there is no white space remaining.


### Step 2: Prepare




Choose a pillow case. Show white side of sequins.

Place your image face-down on the top of your pillow case.

### Step 3: Sending file over



Cut off pieces of heat resistant tape.



Tape the outside edges of your paper to your pillowcase.
