Styrofoam Printmaking

Follow the steps below to make your own prints!
This is a beginner-friend activity for ages 5 and above.

Supplies:

- Styrofoam + paper plates
- Newspaper/paper
- Roller + paint
- Stationary + seals
- Pen, bone folder, scissors

Step 1: Create stencil



Cut tray to size of card/envelope or smaller (make flat).



→ Use pen/pencil to draw stencil (it will be mirrored, fyi). Trace first. Then, press so tip punctures foam.

Step 2: Paint



Squeeze ~1/3 c. of paint on to paper plate and roll roller back and forth through it until it's completely covered.



Place foam on paper. Use roller to cover entire foam print thoroughly.

Step 3: Make prints



Place card/stationary on clean paper. Place foam print face down on card. Use bone folder press print. Be careful to not move the print. Gently lift print. Let dry. Decorate!

Seal with a wax seal and deliver!



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
