## Spring Gnomes

Follow the steps below to make your own spring gnome!  
This is a beginner-friendly activity for ages 5 and above.

### Supplies:

- Felt of various colors
- Semicircle template
- Chunky yarn
- Wood beads
- Hot glue + scissors

### Step 1: Make hat



Cut out the semicircle template. Trace it on felt. Cut the felt.



Glue the overlapping edges of the felt cone-shaped hat to hold in place. (Start with straight side on top.)

### Step 2: Make beard



Wrap yarn around your hand 10 times.



Cut a 5" long strand. Loop under wrapped yarn, removing your hand. Tie strand into tight knot around wrapped yarn. Cut yarn loops to form pom-pom.



### Step 3: Assemble

Cut a ~10 in. piece of yarn. Tie a loop under the pom-pom knot.



Thread loop through hole in hat.



### Add flowers & felt pieces to accessorize.



Glue wooden bead at base of hat.
